§ 1

1. The organizer of the contest is Hugo Kołłątaj High School No 6 in Lublin, Poland

§ 2

1. The aims of the contest are:

1. introducing the students to the works of Andrzej Sapkowski,
2. introducing the students to film adaptations of Andrzej Sapkowski's works as well as games based on *The Witcher* series,
3. promoting reading of high literature,
4. igniting imagination and stimulating sensitivity to written work,
5. developing creativity,
6. developing critical thinking,
7. developing art and literary interests and talents,
8. shaping sensitivity to the written word,
9. developing language skills, reading comprehension and interpreting literary work,
10. developing key competences, 'Cultural awareness and expression' in particular,
11. shaping civic and patriotic attitudes,
12. developing digital skills,
13. promotion of Hugo Kołłątaj High School No 6 in Lublin, the city of Lublin and the Lublin area in Poland and abroad.

§ 3

1. The contest is addressed to students born between 2002 and 2007.
2. Contestants are to send works inspired by a chosen character from *The Witcher* series by Andrzej Sapkowski, a film adaptation of the story or a video game based on the series. Only works which have not been published before and have not been submitted to any other contest are allowed.
3. The contest is divided into two categories:
 - 1) artistic - an illustration of a chosen character from *The Witcher* series,
 - 2) literary - a piece of prose/ poetic work inspired by a chosen character from *The Witcher* series presenting his or her further (alternative) fate.
4. One student can choose either the artistic or the literary category.
5. In the artistic category the contestant is to submit his or her own vision of a chosen character from *The Witcher* series.
 - 1) the artwork submitted to the contest can be created in any technique (drawing, painting, graphic art, etc).
 - 2) The title of the artwork must contain the name of the character presented.
 - 3) Contestants are required to attach a short description of the work and provide the source of inspiration.
6. In the literary category the contestant is to submit a literary work which presents further (or alternative) fate of a chosen character from *The Witcher* series.
 - 1) The literary work must be written in the first person narrative and present the story from the character's point of view: how their fate would have changed if they had made a different decision than the one described in the original story, film adaptation or a video game based on the series.
 - 2) The literary work must be written in one of the languages: Polish, English, German or Russian.
 - 3) Students of Polish schools abroad can submit a work in Polish. The work cannot exceed two A4 pages or 1000 words.

7. The contest is divided into two stages:
 - 1) school stage takes place in the contestant's school: the school jury chooses maximum 5 best works that can be submitted to the next stage,
 - 2) international stage where the works submitted will be assessed by the jury appointed by the organizer.
8. No collective work is allowed.
9. The works will be assessed by a jury appointed by the organizer. The jury consists of the representatives of Hugo Kołłątaj High School No 6 in Lublin, Maria Curie-Skłodowska University, The John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin, Hieronim Łopaciński Provincial Publin Library in Lublin and Hieronim Łopaciński Municipal Public Library in Lublin.
10. The factors taken into consideration while assessing:
 - 1) accordance of the work with the subject of the contest,
 - 2) artistic value, creativity and originality of the work which would encourage the reader/recipient of the artwork to get acquainted with Andrzej Sapkowski's series as well as audiovisual works inspired by or based on Andrzej Sapkowski's prose,
 - 3) stylistic and language accuracy of the literary work.
11. The winners will receive in-kind prizes and certificates.
12. The jury reserves the right to award additional prizes and honorable mentions.
13. The jury's decision is final.

§ 4

1. The school jury can send the chosen works on a CD to the organizer. The envelope should be addressed: **THE SECOND EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL ART AND LITERARY CONTEST – MY HERO/HEROINE OF *THE WITCHER* SERIES: ADD SOME COLOR, GIVE IT YOUR VOICE, VI Liceum Ogólnokształcące im. Hugona Kołłątaja w Lublinie, ul. Mickiewicza 36, 20-466 Lublin, Poland.** The work can also be sent by e-mail at: poczta@lo6.lublin.eu

2. The work submitted should include:
 - 1) in the artistic category: the scan of the illustration in JPG, min. resolution 1920 x 2460, and a short description providing the source of inspiration (written in Polish, English, German or Russian),
 - 2) in the literary category: the text in a pdf, doc or docx format,
 - 3) written statement describing the school stage (Attachment 2),
 - 4) signed documents:
 - a) parent's/legal guardian's consent when the contestant is underage (Attachment 3),
 - b) copyright statement and personal image release consent (Attachment 4),
 - c) information clause (Attachment 5).
3. Works sent by mail need to be on a CD. The CD must include the contestant's name and the information about the category of the contest.
4. The submitted works which are incomplete or sent after the deadline will not be assessed.
5. The date on the stamp or the date the e-mail hits the inbox is taken into account.

§ 5

1. Sending the work means that the student submitting it:
 - 1) is the author of the submitted illustration/ piece of the literary work and has unlimited copyright, and the work submitted has not been published or has not taken part in other contests.
 - 2) accepts the rules of the contest,
 - 3) grants to Hugo Kołłątaj High School No 6 permission to use the submitted works free of charge in any form and time in order to promote the organizer, the partners and the sponsors of the contest.

INFORMATION CLAUSE ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING OF A PARTICIPANT

In accordance with Article 14 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 /EC (Official Journal of the European Union L. 2016.119.1), General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as "GDPR", we inform that:

1) The Administrator of your personal data in connection with THE INTERNATIONAL ART AND LITERARY CONTEST: MY HERO/HEROINE OF *THE WITCHER* SERIES: ADD SOME COLOR, GIVE IT YOUR VOICE is Hugo Kołtataj High School No 6 based in Lublin at ul. Mickiewicza 36, 20-466 Lublin.

2) There has been assigned a Data Protection Regulator who can be contacted via email: lo6@iod.lublin.eu or traditional letter sent to the administrator of your personal data.

3) The participant's personal data (name, surname, year of birth, name of school they attend) and underage participant's legal guardian's personal data (name and surname) included in the registration form as well as the participant's picture will be processed for the purpose of conducting and advertising The International Art and Literary Contest: My Hero/Heroine of *The Witcher* Series: Add some colour, give it your voice, hereinafter referred to as the Contest and afterwards for the purpose of archiving it.

4) The participant's and his/her legal guardian's personal data were obtained from the registration form, which had been sent by the coordinating teacher from the participant's school.

5) The basis for data processing is the consent to data processing given in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 GDPR and Article 81 of the Act on copyright and related rights (February, 4, 1994) regarding dissemination of the image in order to promote an event.

6) The consent to processing personal data of the participant (name, surname, year of birth and name of school they attend) is necessary to participate in the contest. The consent to dissemination of the image is voluntary and does not affect participation in the contest. The consent to dissemination of the image can be withdrawn any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing of data which was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

7) The data will be processed until all activities connected with organizing and promoting the contest are completed or until consent is withdrawn. Personal data will be stored for 5 years for archival purposes.

8) The Educational Office in Lublin can be the recipient of personal data.

9) Personal data will not be subject to automated processing of data based on automated decision making, in particular they will not be subject to profiling.

10) It is ensured that all persons whose personal data is processed have appropriate rights resulting from the GDPR. Therefore, you have:

- a) the right to access your personal data;
- b) the right to request correction (revision) of your personal data;

- c) the right to request the deletion of your personal data in the cases determined in art.17 GDPR;
- d) the right to restrict personal data in the cases determined in art.18 GDPR;
- e) the right to withdraw your consent to processing your personal data;
- f) the right to transfer your personal data in the cases determined in art. 20 GDPR;
- g) the right to lodge a complaint to the President of Data Protection Office in case your data is processed unlawfully.
