§ 1

1. The organizer of the contest is Hugo Kołłątaj High School No 6 in Lublin, Poland
2. The partners of the contest are Maria Curie-Skłodowska University of Lublin, the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin, American Corner Lublin:

§ 2

1. The aims of the contest are:
 1. introducing the students to the works of contemporary Nobel Prize winners for literature,
 2. promoting reading of high literature,
 3. igniting imagination and stimulating sensitivity to written work,
 4. developing creativity,
 5. developing critical thinking,
 6. developing art and literary interests and talents,
 7. shaping sensitivity to the written word,
 8. developing language skills, reading comprehension and interpreting literary work,
 9. developing key competences, 'Cultural awareness and expression' in particular,
 10. developing digital literary skills.
2. Contestants are to send one artwork to a chosen excerpt of a literary piece by a Nobel Prize winner for literature OR a piece of prose/ poetic work inspired by a chosen excerpt of a literary piece by a Nobel Prize winner for literature. Only works which have not been published before and have not been submitted to any other contest are allowed. A literary piece of a contemporary (after 1945) Nobel Prize winner for literature should be the source of inspiration for the contestants.
3. The literary piece of the Nobel Prize winner must be available in one of the following languages: Polish, English, German or Russian.

§ 3

1. The contest is addressed to students born between 2000 and 2006.
2. The contest is divided into two categories:
 - 1) artistic - an illustration to a chosen excerpt of a literary piece by a Nobel Prize winner for literature,
 - 2) literary - a piece of prose/ poetic work inspired by a chosen excerpt of a literary piece by a Nobel Prize winner for literature.
3. The artistic category: the artwork submitted to the contest can be created in any technique (drawing, painting, graphic art, etc) Contestants are required to attach the appropriate literary excerpt that is illustrated in their work.
4. The literary category: The contestants are to submit a literary work which is an alternative ending OR a follow-up to the excerpt of a literary piece of a Nobel Prize winner for literature. The literary work must be written in one of the languages: Polish, English, German or Russian. Students of Polish schools abroad can submit a work in Polish. The work cannot exceed two A4 pages or 1000 words.
5. The contestants are divided into two age groups:
 - 1) students aged 14-15,
 - 2) students aged 16 - 19
6. No collective work is allowed. One student can choose either the artistic or the literary category.
7. The works will be assessed by a jury appointed by the organizer. The jury consists of the representatives of Hugo Kollataj High School No 6 in Lublin, Maria Curie-Skłodowska University, The John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin.
8. The factors taken into consideration while assessing:
 - 1) accordance of the work with the subject of the contest,
 - 2) correlation between the illustration and the excerpt,
 - 3) artistic value, cohesion, creativity and originality of the work, which would encourage the reader to broaden their knowledge of the Nobel Prize winner and his/her literature,
 - 4) stylistic and language accuracy of the literary work.
9. The winners will receive in-kind prizes and certificates.
10. The jury reserves the right to award additional prizes and honorable mentions.
11. The jury's decision is final.

§ 4

1. The work can be sent via mail. The envelope should be addressed: **THE INTERNATIONAL ART AND LITERARY CONTEST: MASTERPIECES OF NOBEL PRIZE WINNERS FOR LITERATURE: ADD SOME COLOR, GIVE IT YOUR VOICE** at VI Liceum Ogólnokształcące im. 2. The work submitted should include:
 - 1) artistic category: the scan of the illustration in JPG, min. resolution 1920 x 2460, and the appropriate literary excerpt that is illustrated in their work,
 - 2) literary category: the work in pdf format,
 - 3) The work sent via mail should be recorded on a CD; the CD should be provided with: the name, surname and category.
3. The submitted works which are incomplete or sent after the deadline will not be assessed. The date on the stamp or the date the e-mail hits the inbox is taken into account.

§ 5

1. The schedule of the contest
 - a. the beginning of the contest **January 7, 2020**
 - b. sending application forms **January 31, 2020** (application form - attached)
 - c. sending the works **February 15, 2020**
 - d. announcement of the winners **March 16, 2020**
2. The contest results will be published on the school www.lo6.lublin.eu
3. The winners will be notified by e-mail.
4. The prizes will be sent to the addresses given in the application forms.
5. The awarded works will be presented on the multimedia exhibition on the school website.

§ 6

 - 2) accepts the rules of the contest,
